

Sellenger's Round

Sellenger's Round (sometimes spelled Sellinger's Rownde is an old Folk Dance melody (sometimes called "The Beginning of the World"). It is thought to have originated in Ireland and it became very popular in England in the 16th century. The composer William Byrd wrote a set of variations on the melody for the Virginal and this version has been preserved in a couple of hand-written collections held in English museums: the "Fitzwilliam Virginal Book" and "My Ladye Nevells Booke."
